STANDARD PRICING SCHEDULE: SGBBE
SMART GRID BEST BILL EXCEPTION RIDER

STATE OF OKLAHOMA

EFFECTIVE IN: The Oklahoma Retail Jurisdiction.

EXPIRATION: This rider expires on November 30, 2011.

APPLICABILITY: This exception will be applied to Smart Grid Demand Response study participants who are enrolled in the Residential Time-of-Use (R-TOU), Residential Time-of-Use with Critical Peak Pricing (RT-CPP), Residential Variable Peak Pricing (R-VPP), General Service Time-of-Use (GS-TOU), General Service Time-of-Use with Critical Peak Pricing (GST-CPP), and General Service Variable Peak Pricing (GS-VPP) tariffs.

DESCRIPTION: The SGBBE Rider overrides the Best Bill provision of the applicable tariffs. Typically, the standard Best Bill provision provides for a true-up of billing for usage based on the customer's otherwise applicable tariff after one full year of participation. However, the SGBBE Rider will allow a true-up at the conclusion of the applicable year's test period, as outlined in the *Determination of True-Up* provisions below.

In addition, the Residential customer's otherwise applicable tariff will be the R-1 tariff, and the General Service customer's otherwise applicable tariff will be the GS tariff.

DETERMINATION OF TRUE-UP 2010: Participants for the full test period in 2010 will have the Best Bill provision applied in conjunction with or subsequent to their October 2010 billing. Following the application of the Best Bill provision in 2010, the Best Bill provision will not be available to these study participants in subsequent years.

DETERMINATION OF TRUE-UP 2011: Participants for the full test period in 2011, who did not participate in the 2010 test period, will have the Best Bill provision applied in conjunction with or subsequent to their billing in October 2011. Following the application of the Best Bill provision in 2011, the Best Bill provision will not be available to these study participants in subsequent years.
